Accordingly, all residences and properties with a structure should have one of the below green or red metal signs posted in close proximity to the driveway. In cases of common driveways, a sign should be posted at the street designating the range of addresses on the common drive and then signs for each individual private drive. The Police Department maintains a database of these addresses, commonly referred to as "fire grids" and equally relies on them to efficiently locate structures in emergency situations. Accordingly, it is imperative that your sign is clearly legible, free of any obstructions (e.g. snow or landscaping), and that you correct and/or report any issues with it.
